Dear Mayor

You were kind enough to meet with a delegation from the Wolli Creek Preservation Society on 15 December 2005, at which we provided information about the development of a long-distance walk along the Wolli and Cooks Valleys. We noted with some concern that developments had been announced for Waterworth Park that would potentially be incompatible with this proposal. You undertook to arrange for us to be consulted about these proposals before they went further, and we are now seeking that consultation.

Since our meeting with you, we have been able to find more details of the proposals through publicly available documents, specifically in the report of the Director, City Works to the City Services Committee on 13 October 2005. On the basis of the information provided in that report and its attached map and our own surveys and mapping of the area, we have developed an initial Society position on the proposals. Our position paper is attached for your information, and as background for the consultation process. (The enclosed maps, to which the paper refers, can be made available as .pdf files to assist their duplication, if needed.)
