



Looking down from Johnston St - the ribbon between the two trees is 3m long - the REF claims the path would be 1.8m. It is even wider than 3m further down. The REF claims it would be 40m long....The whole length has been clear-felled and whipper-snipped.



Looking up towards Johnston St - much wider than 3m.



The area cleared around the access shaft (arrowed) - the REF claimed "no clearing or trimming of vegetation required." It has been stripped bare for about 10m x 8m.



Quite substantial trees have been cut down and the trunks, limbs and branches dumped haphazardly on top of regenerating native vegetation.



No consideration has been shown to the extensive historic terracing created by Andrew Bowen in the 1930s, using stone from the site,
