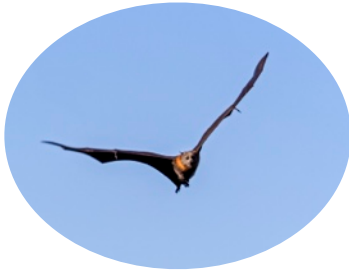


# 'Bat Watch' Picnic Friday March 11, 2016
