



**LET US KNOW WHERE YOU STAND -  
A SURVEY ON THE WESTCONNEX MOTORWAY**

The Wolli Creek Preservation Society (WCPS) is a volunteer-run organisation dedicated to protecting and enhancing the bushland and waterways of the Wolli and Bardwell Valleys, the only bushland of substantial size left in inner south-west Sydney.

Our membership comprises almost 400 people, the majority of whom reside in the State electorates of Canterbury, Kogarah, Rockdale, Dulwich Hill, Heffron, Lakemba and Newtown. We also have 600 Facebook supporters and communicate regularly via Twitter.

WCPS is conducting the below single question survey, which is being sent to all known Liberal, Labor and Green candidates in the above electorates, on behalf of our members and supporters. We will be communicating each candidate's position on this issue to our stakeholder group in the lead up to the 2015 State election.

1. I accept that Stage 2 of WestConnex as currently proposed will involve major destruction of Wolli Creek bushland, however, roads have to be built somewhere and I'm prepared to sacrifice two hectares of the Wolli Creek bushland for it to go ahead.
2. I accept that Stage 2 of WestConnex as currently proposed will involve major destruction of Wolli Creek bushland, but will press my political allies to insist on strict controls to minimise damage to the bushland and creek.
3. I accept that the M5 East needs to be duplicated, but I will press my political allies to insist that a way be found to do this that doesn't impact Wolli Creek bushland or the creek.
4. I believe that there should be no interference with the Wolli Creek bushland or waterway, that Stage 2 of WestConnex should be abandoned altogether and the funds used to make improvements to public transport in the south-west corridor, its catchment and destination areas. I will be urging my political allies to adopt this position.
