Alternative project for Wolli Creek Corridor

Turn Unwin St into a 'green street' to link Waterworth Park and the Regional Park:

- acquire the vacant blocks in the street (currently owned by Planning) to increase green space.
- regenerate low heath vegetation on no. 11 (16 Sec B DP4709) between Bayview Ave and Unwin St.
- revegetate no.s 14,16,18 (35,36,37 Sec B DP4709) with mixed plantings of species local to the Regional Park.
- install a raingarden/wetland at the bottom of Unwin St (often pooled with water) with a footbridge over it to cross from Waterworth Park to Unwin St. This could help improve water quality at the same time.
- introduce street tree plantings up both sides of Unwin St with mixed small tree species local to Regional Park (eg the local white-flowered Blueberry Ash (*Eleocarpus reticulatus*), *Tristaniopsis collina*, *Rapanea variabilis*).
- provide education, opportunities and plants for local residents to extend the local species theme into their gardens.

This could serve as a small model for other areas near existing corridors.
